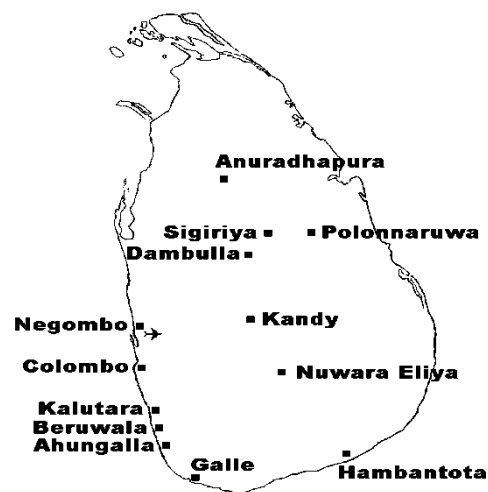

Day 1 – Airport → Colombo (40 km / 1.5 hrs)

Meet & greet at Colombo International Airport. Transfer to Colombo. Afternoon city tour including Gangaramaya Temple, a Hindu Temple, Wolvendaal Dutch Church, Hultsdorf Law Courts, and Independence Square. Drive through Pettah Bazaar, Fort area, and Cinnamon Gardens.



Overnight: PEGASUS REEF

Day 2 – Colombo → Negombo (40 km / 1 hr)

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy the laid-back beach town of Negombo. Visit the **Dutch Canal**, explore the colonial **St. Mary's Church**, and stroll through the **local fish market**, one of the island's most vibrant.



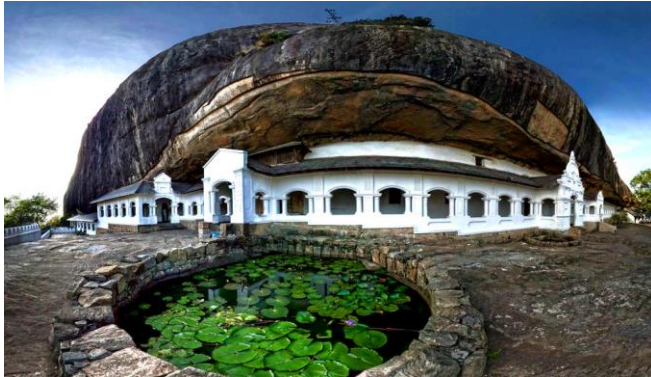
Overnight: ARIEE LAGOON

Day 3 – Negombo → Pinnawala → Dambulla (160 km / 4.5 hrs)

Visit Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage en route. Proceed to Dambulla. Visit Dambulla Rock Cave Temple, a UNESCO site with Buddha statues and cave murals.

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage - Observe rescued elephants, including babies, in a natural setting. See them bathe in the river and learn about conservation efforts at this internationally known sanctuary.

Dambulla Cave Temple (Golden Temple of Dambulla) - A UNESCO World Heritage Site, this iconic cave complex contains over 150 Buddha statues and intricate murals, all nestled within five rock-cut caves that date back to the 1st century BC.

Day 4 – Excursion to Anuradhapura & Mihintale (240 km / 8 hrs)

Tour the ancient city of Anuradhapura: Sri Maha Bodhi, Ruwanwelisaya, Isurumuniya Rock Temple, Twin Ponds, Thuparama Dagoba. Continue to Mihintale – the cradle of Buddhism in Sri Lanka.

Anuradhapura Ancient City - Sri Lanka's first kingdom and a UNESCO site. See the Sri Maha Bodhi Tree, over 2,000 years old; the immense Ruwanwelisaya Stupa; Isurumuniya Rock Temple; Twin Ponds; and the sacred Thuparamaya Dagoba, the first Buddhist dagoba in Sri Lanka.

Mihintale - Regarded as the birthplace of Buddhism in Sri Lanka. Climb the stone steps to visit the Aradhana Gala, Ambasthala Dagoba, and monastic ruins while enjoying panoramic views of the plains.



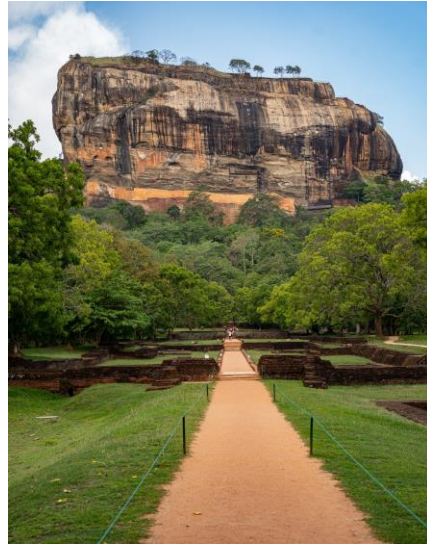

Day 5 – Dambulla → Sigiriya → Polonnaruwa → Dambulla (224 km / 8 hrs)

Climb the Sigiriya Rock Fortress, a 5th-century royal citadel. Explore Polonnaruwa: Royal Palace ruins, Gal Viharaya, Audience Hall, and Parakrama Samudraya.

Sigiriya Rock Fortress - One of Sri Lanka's most iconic sites, this 5th-century UNESCO World Heritage fortress rises 200 meters from the jungle. Climb past frescoes and the famous Lion's Paws to the summit palace for breathtaking views

Polonnaruwa Ancient City - Explore the medieval capital of Sri Lanka. Highlights include the Royal Palace ruins, Gal Viharaya with its four colossal Buddha statues carved into rock, Parakrama Samudraya Reservoir, and the Sacred Quadrangle.

Day 6 – Dambulla → Matale → Kandy (130 km / 5 hrs)

Visit a Coconut House and Spice Garden in Matale. Drive to Kandy. Enjoy a cultural dance show and visit the Temple of the Tooth Relic.

Matale Spice Garden & Coconut House - Learn about Sri Lanka's spice heritage and Ayurveda traditions. See how cinnamon, nutmeg, pepper, and cardamom are cultivated, and enjoy a short demonstration on traditional uses.

Kandy Cultural Show & Temple of the Tooth Relic - Watch a colorful performance of traditional Kandyan dance and drumming. Visit the sacred Temple of the Tooth Relic (Sri Dalada Maligawa), home to a revered relic of the Buddha.



Overnight: TOPAZ KANDY

Day 7 – Kandy → Nuwara Eliya (90 km / 3 hrs)

Visit a tea plantation and factory. Walk around Gregory Lake. Discover colonial charm of Nuwara Eliya. Tea Plantation & Factory Visit

Tour a working tea estate in the misty highlands. Learn about tea picking and processing—from leaf to cup—and enjoy freshly brewed Ceylon tea with views over rolling plantations.

Gregory Lake, Nuwara Eliya - Walk along the tranquil Gregory Lake, surrounded by colonial-era bungalows and misty mountains. This area is known as “Little England” for its cool climate and British-inspired charm.



Overnight: ARALIYA RED

Day 8 – Horton Plains Excursion

Early morning visit to Horton Plains National Park and World's End. Return to Nuwara Eliya for leisure.

Horton Plains National Park & World's End - Trek through grasslands and cloud forests to reach World's End, a dramatic escarpment with a sheer 870-meter drop. The park is also home to unique flora, waterfalls, and wildlife like sambar deer.



Overnight: ARALIYA RED

Day 9 – Nuwara Eliya → Ella (60 km / 2.5 hrs)

Take scenic drive or train to Ella. Visit Nine Arches Bridge and hike Little Adam's Peak.

Ella Sightseeing - Visit the postcard-famous Nine Arches Bridge, built during the British colonial era, and enjoy a gentle hike up Little Adam's Peak for sweeping views over Ella Gap and the surrounding tea hills.



Overnight: 88 ELLA

Day 10 – Ella → Yala (150 km / 4 hrs)

Drive to Yala. Evening jeep safari in Yala National Park to spot leopards and elephants.

Yala National Park Safari - Experience an exciting jeep safari in Sri Lanka's most famous wildlife park. Spot leopards, elephants, crocodiles, sloth bears, and a wide variety of birds in their natural habitat.



Overnight: MAGAMPURA ECO RESORT

Day 11 – Yala → Mirissa (160 km / 4.5 hrs)

Optional early morning safari. Proceed to Mirissa. Relax by the beach.



Overnight: MANDARA RESORT

Day 12 – Mirissa → Galle → Bentota (160 km / 4 hrs)

Visit Galle Fort – a colonial Dutch fort and UNESCO site. Continue to Bentota.

Galle Fort - Explore the UNESCO-listed Dutch Fort in Galle, with its cobbled streets, colonial buildings, lighthouse, and coastal ramparts. The fort is a blend of European and South Asian architectural styles and cultures.

Bentota & Madu River (Optional) - Enjoy beach leisure in Bentota or take an optional Madu River boat safari through mangroves, stopping at cinnamon plantations and tiny islets with temples. Also ideal for water sports and Ayurveda treatments.



Overnight: EARLES REEF

Day 13 – Bentota (Leisure Day)

Free day to enjoy the beach. Optional activities: water sports or river safari.



Overnight: EARLES REEF

Day 14 – Bentota → Airport (110 km / 2.5 hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Colombo International Airport for departure.
