



Day 1: Sigiriya

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage: Located about 55 miles from Colombo, this orphanage houses over 65 elephants, including many babies. It's a great place to witness these majestic animals during feeding and bathing times (9:30-10:00 AM and 1:30-2:00 PM). You'll see elephants play in the river during

bathing time.

Sigiriya Rock Fortress: Known as the "Lion Rock," this UNESCO World Heritage site is a 600-foot-high rock with ancient ruins at the summit. You'll see the foundations of a Royal Palace, water tanks, guardhouses, and beautiful frescoes of life-sized damsels painted in vibrant colors. The climb up takes around 3 hours, but the views and historical significance are worth it.



Day 2: Kandy

Dambulla Cave Temple: The largest and best-preserved cave temple complex in Sri Lanka, dating back to the 1st century BC. The caves feature over 150 Buddha statues, including a 47-foot-long reclining Buddha. The ceiling is decorated with frescoes of significant Buddhist events.

Matale Spice Garden & Gem Gallery: Learn about Sri Lanka's rich spice trade at the Matale Spice

Garden, and visit a Gem Gallery to see the famous Sri Lankan gemstones.

Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic: This temple houses Sri Lanka's most sacred Buddhist relic – the tooth of the Buddha, brought to the island in the 4th century AD. It is a highly revered site for Buddhists worldwide.

Day 3: Nuwara Eliya



- St. Clair's Falls & Devon Falls: On your way to Colombo, stop to enjoy the breathtaking St. Clair's and Devon Falls, two of the largest and most scenic waterfalls in Sri Lanka.





Day 1: Dambulla

- Arrival in Sri Lanka: You'll be welcomed upon arrival and transferred to Chilaw.
- Visit Munneshwaram Temple: This ancient Hindu temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, is one of Sri Lanka's five major Shiva temples. It is linked to the legend of King Rama, who is believed to have prayed here to atone for the sin of Brahmahast (killing a Brahmin).
- **Visit Manavari Temple:** Located near Chilaw, this is the first place where Lord Rama installed a Shiva Lingam as a remedy for his sin.
